

Streetlight Reporting application built on Operations Dashboard


The streetlight reporting application is used by the public & government to track each streetlight. Streetlights in Flint are maintained by Consumers Energy and the City of Flint. All streetlights are on the map whether it is a High Pressure Sodium, Mercury, LED or **Decorative Street** Light. There are so many capabilities with this application, but the best may be giving the public a way of contributing to make their home safe.


Highlights of the Operations Dashboard:

- City employee or resident can report a variety of problems with a streetlight, e.g. burnt out, flickering, broken / vandalized or on during the day.
- Status reported in real-time limits calls to check on the problem
- Reported date recorded immediately
- Notification number is generated within 24 hours & can be used to track Consumers Energy's repair status
- Helps Consumers Energy crews find streetlights at vacant property
- Dashboard statistics can be filtered by neighborhood
