"The OCWPA also ensures that the public can **report drinking water concerns** through the statewide concerns reporting system and that those **concerns are heard and investigated** by the <u>appropriate</u> entity."

#### Install Survey123 for Desktop (Drinking Water Concern Form)

Locate and open the Software Center application on your computer. If do not know where it is, use the search Locate and open the Software Center application on your computer. If do not know where it is function on your task bar (or click the magnifying glass icon) and simply type "Software Center".

#### 2. Install Survey123

Within Software Center, use the search function and type in "Survey123". Select "Survey123 for ArcGIS" to get to the application details screen; then click the blue install button. Follow the instructions

NOTE: Two applications may appear in your search results - do on the screen. NOT download "Survey123 Connect for ArcGIS".

Once installed, locate and open Survey123. You may see the program  $A=\pi r^2$ as a small, rectangular window, you can resize this or maximize this screen if you want.

NOTE: You may get an "Unable to connect: position sour closed error" when first opening the program - disregard t error. This simply refers to the application's ability to pinp( cos your location - click 'Ok'.






#### Summary

ArcGIS Dashboards supports embedded content in dashboard elements. The content may vary from images and videos, to website pages and more. Embedding surveys from ArcGIS Survey123 combines the visual appeal and understanding of Dashboards with real-time data editing and response.

This article describes how to embed a survey form from ArcGIS Survey123 in ArcGIS Dashboards, and customize the form to edit existing data.










- Feature introduced August 2019 by Esri StoryMaps team
